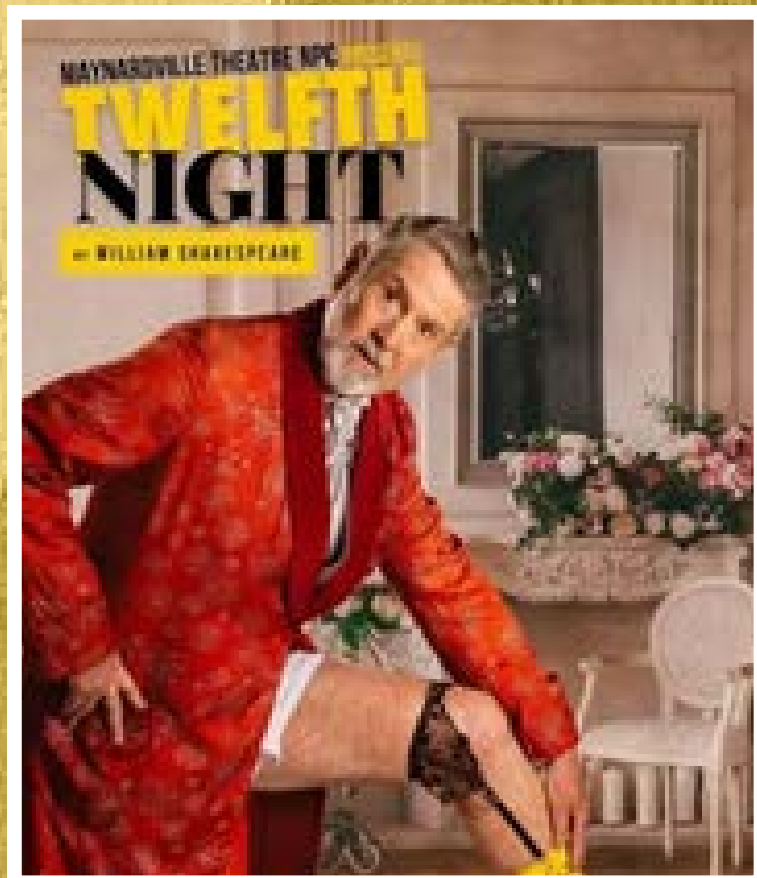

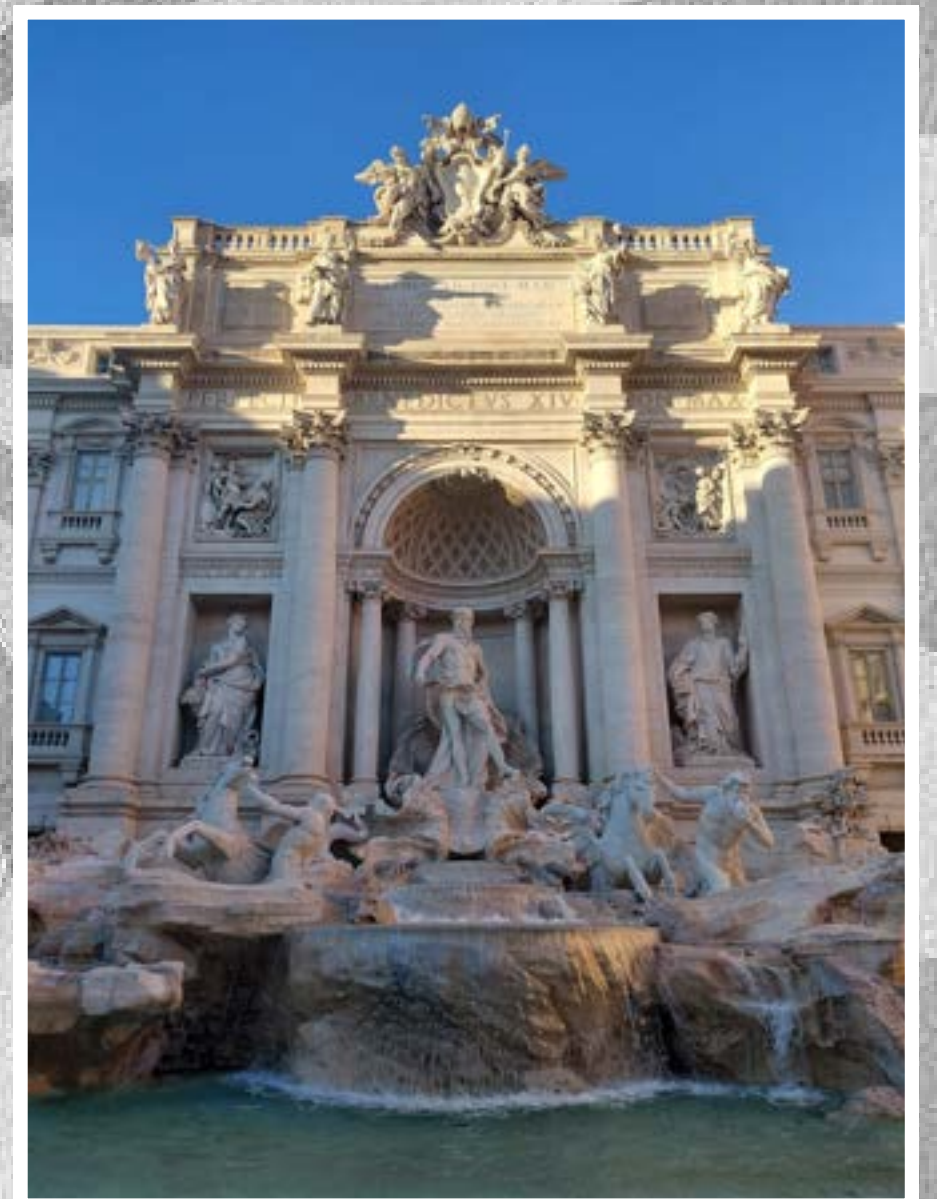

Time made it easier. My host family shared their traditions, their history, and made me feel part of the family. Slowly, routines became natural, and I even became a bit more open and social than I expected.

Italy itself was unforgettable. I visited Verona, Montagnana, and went down south for Christmas, where we explored Matera. One of my biggest dreams came true when we visited Pompeii, and later Rome. Venice was magical too. Every city, every view, every meal felt like a story I was living.

The food was off the scale delicious - pizza and pasta that I will never forget - and, enjoyed with breath-taking scenery. One evening in Verona, climbing a castle at sunset with my host sister and her friends, I realised: I was actually there. And the people? So welcoming and friendly! Very eager to share their culture and traditions.

If anyone is considering an exchange trip, I cannot recommend it enough. It is challenging, yes, but it is also life-changing. Even now, looking back at my photos, it still feels like a dream, but one I will never forget.

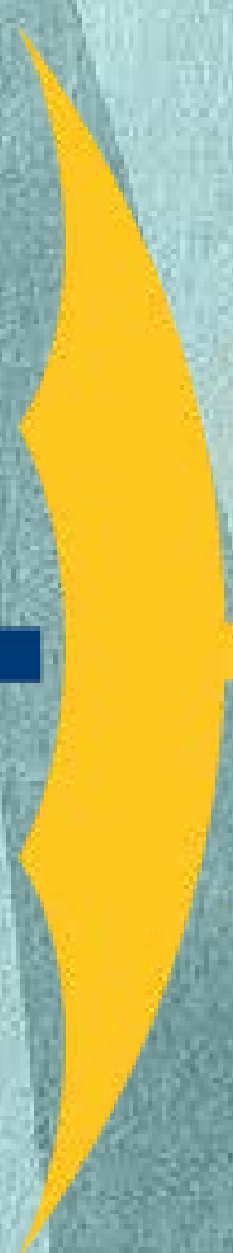

Hallo almal!

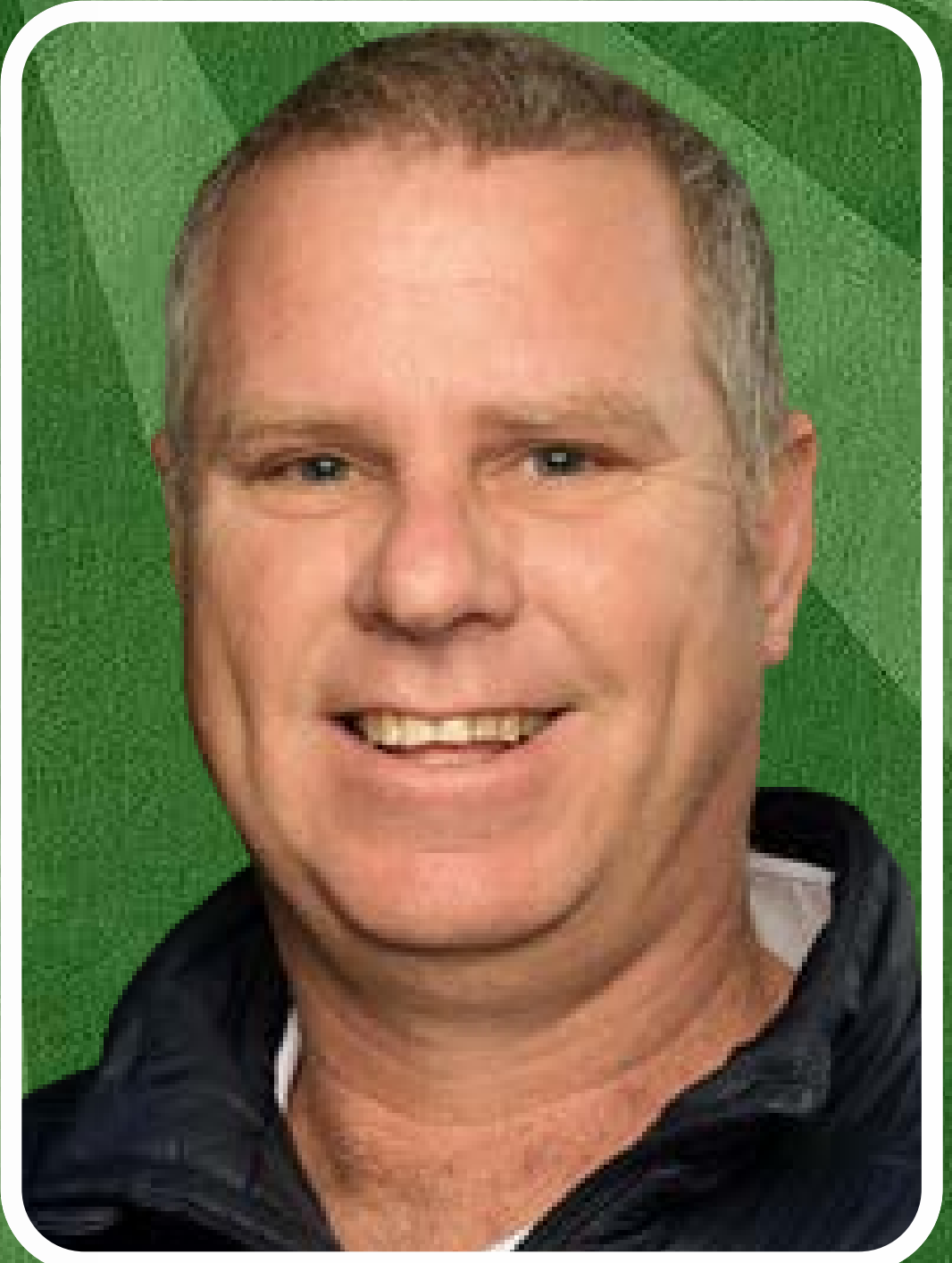

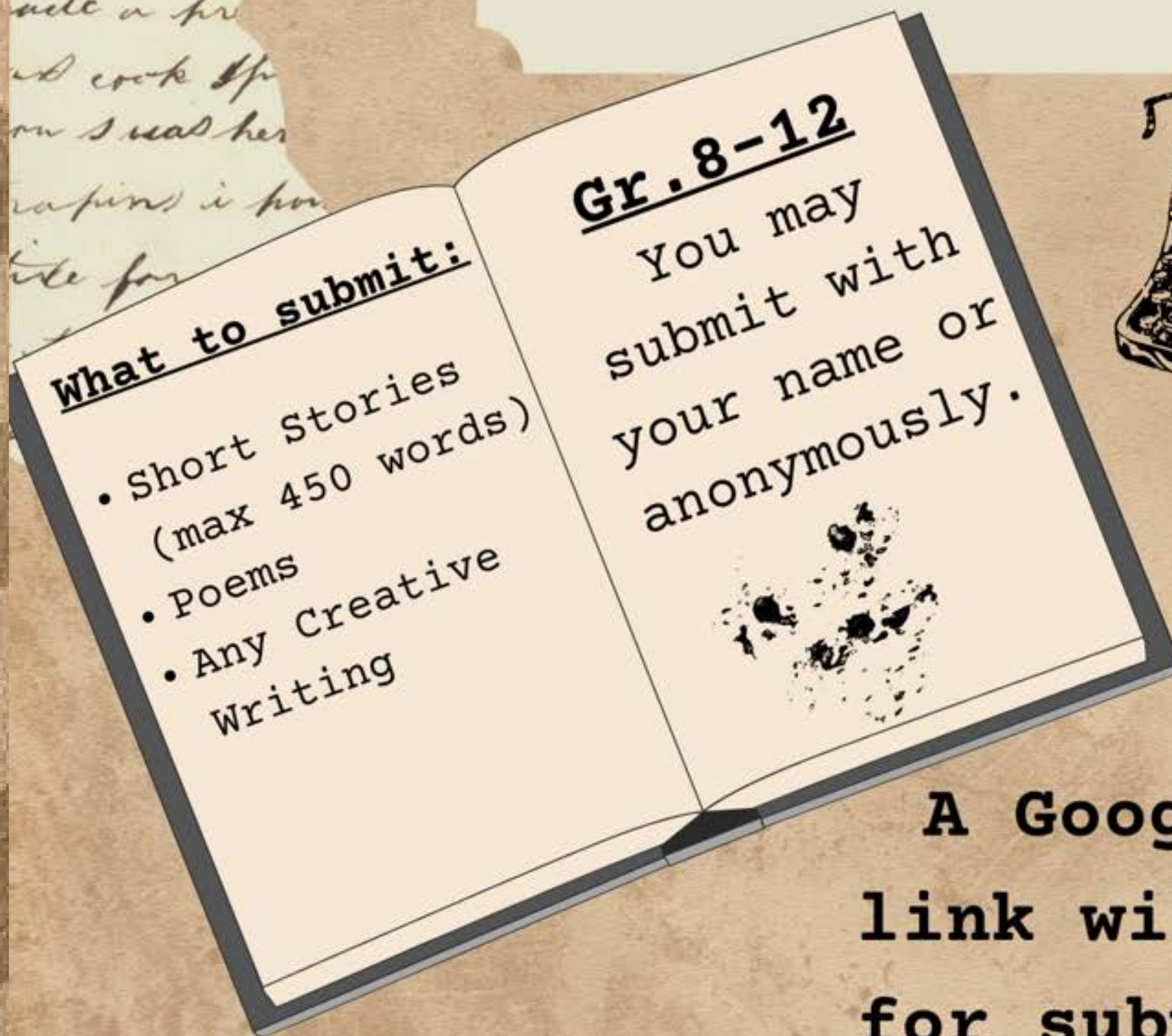
