4. Skoolgetalle

Op hierdie stadium staan HSH se skoolgetalle op 720 vanaf Gr. R – 12. Die laerskoolgetalle staan op 236 terwyl daar 485 leerders in die hoërskool is. Die gewildheid van HSH is elke jaar besig om met rasse skrede toe te neem en dit is verseker bemoedigend vir ouers om te hoor dat die Beheerliggaam uit hulle pad gaan om te verseker dat klasgetalle hanteerbaar is.

5. Subject choices

Parents are reminded that Gr. 12 learners are not allowed to make subject changes in Gr. 12. Gr. 11 learners must submit their subject changes (two subjects only) before 15 March. Grade 10 learners have until 13 June to submit their subject changes (2 subjects). We urge parents to make absolutely certain that subject changes do not exclude learners from studies at universities or universities of technology.

7. **Text and exercise books**

All text and exercise books must be covered with plastic on Tuesday, 31 January. Class teachers will do a book inspection on this date to see to it that all books are covered properly.

8. **SMS-stelsel**

9. **Library**

Mrs Suria Basson has been appointed as librarian with the focus to develop the library as a centre of excellence where learners can benefit from what is on offer. Parents who are willing to donate books or DVD's of educational value are more than welcome to do so.

11. **Dissipline**

Effektiewe dissipline is een van die hoekstene van HSH se suksesverhaal en dit gaan verseker so bly.

Ons vestig ouers se aandag daarop dat HSH 'n puntestelsel het waarvolgens leerders punte verloor vir negatiewe gedrag / oortredings, of positiewe punte kry vir positiewe gedrag. U is welkom om ons dissiplinêre beampte, mev. Cathrin Maree, te kontak gedurende skoolure i.v.m. navrae oor u kind se punte t.o.v. gedrag.

We want to stress the fact that all learners must wear school uniform or the official school sports dress when attending school sport matches. Please see to it that learners adhere to this rule.

According to our Code of Conduct one form of corrective discipline is detention. Detention will take place on Fridays and not on any other day of the week. **Parents are responsible for learners' transport after detention - not the school. We also remind**

parents that HSH is a cell phone free area and that learners are not allowed to bring cell phones to school or any school activities. Cell phones will be confiscated for up to three calendar months. The Governing Body approved one rule change with regards to cell phones. The use of cell phones are allowed on our school buses. All other rules with regards to cell phones still apply.

12. Protocol

HSH strives for excellence, but we are certainly not perfect. What are parents to do when they experience problems? If the problem is curriculum-related, contact the subject teacher or consult with the teacher on Parent Evenings. If the outcome of this conversation is not satisfactory, contact the principal. If you have any other queries, contact the teacher in charge and if you are not happy, contact the principal.

13. Report Cards

In the past we received numerous requests to e-mail or fax report cards. We agreed to do it, but were informed that WCED policy states that report cards are legal documents and parents must receive the original report card. **Therefore no report cards will be faxed or e-mailed in future.** Report cards will be handed over personally to each learner on the last day of each school term.

14. L.O.-Klere

16. Swimming Caps and sport caps

Due to problems with hair in our filters, pupils must have swimming caps when they use the school's pool. Caps may be bought at school from Mrs Cathrin Maree. **Parents are also informed that only official HSH sport caps may be worn during school sport activities.** These caps may also be bought from Mrs Maree.

17. Homework books

We want to stress the fact that every learner **must** have a homework book.

18. School Attendance

We want to stress the fact that school attendance during the last week of the school term is compulsory and that formal assessment tasks will be completed in all grades during the last week of the first 3 terms.

24. School uniform

Gr. 8 parents are informed of the arrangements that all Gr. 8 boys must wear short grey pants during terms 1 and 4. **School blazers are compulsory for Gr. 8 – 12 learners from 1 May to 30 September. Track suits tops will no longer be part of formal school dress for Gr. 8 and 9.**

25. Skooltasse

Graffiti op skooltasse word geensins toegelaat nie en is beslis nie iets wat binne die kultuur van HSH val nie. Ons versoek ouers om toe te sien dat leerders aan die begin van die nuwe skooljaar geen graffiti op skooltasse sal hê nie en dat ouers ook sal toesien dat slegs swart of donkerblou tasse met interne versterking aangekoop word om te verseker dat leerders se boeke in 'n goeie toestand sal bly.

26. School Bags

We remind parents that school bags can be ordered at the school. The bags are in two sizes (big and small) and are in the colours of the school with the school's badge printed on it. Contact Mrs Cathrin Maree to place an order as soon as possible.

27. Marking of school uniform

Parents are requested to see to it that all school and sport uniforms are clearly marked. The secretary's office is packed with lost school uniforms, especially after sport events, and these costly uniforms are rarely claimed. We have more than 700 learners with exactly the same uniforms and if the items are not clearly marked, there will be confusion. Thank you for your co-operation.

28. Learners out of school grounds

We are living in dangerous times, even in the tranquility of Hopefield. We need to manage these risks at school and therefore we need to inform parents that no learner will be allowed to leave the school grounds during school hours. The only exception will be when a parent or legal guardian accompanies a learner in person from the school grounds, with a valid reason and with permission from the headmaster.

29. Illness during examinations / assessment

It happens from time to time that learners fall ill during exams or when Formal Assessment Tasks are completed. **When learners are absent, the school must be informed and a doctor's or clinic certificate must be handed in at school.** When a learner is absent with a valid medical certificate, the learner will get an 'absent' and his/her term mark will reflect all the other tasks completed for that specific subject. In such cases no learner will receive a class average mark or a zero mark.

We also get requests to accommodate learners not feeling well during exam/assessment by letting them taking their tests outside the normal exam times.

We simply cannot manage these requests any more for the simple reasons of question paper security and time constraints. We certainly appreciate the fact that a learner who is not feeling well, still wants to complete his/her exam papers, but these exam papers must be completed at the same time as the other learners completing these subjects.

A very important change is that hard copies of the newsletter will not be handed out to learners. This is a very time-consuming, costly exercise and the most majority of our parents and learners have the ability to download the newsletter and other communication digitally. If there is an urgent and valid need for a hard copy, contact the school.

31. Subsidies and exemption of school fees

All school and bus fees must be paid in advance and we depend on your support. Only your punctual payments will relieve the pressure on the cash flow of the school. Interest will be charged on accounts in arrear. Parents who qualify for exemption on school and hostel fees must please fetch the forms as **soon as possible** from Mrs Burger, our financial secretary. Completed forms must be handed in **no later than 25 January**. Forms must be handed in with all required documentation. Exemption forms are available at the financial office from 10 January 2019. Parents must also note that school fees will be charged over a period of 11 months. Contact Mrs Suanne Burger at 022 7230040 about any queries you might have about the exemption process.

If your account is in arrears for 90 days, 5% interest will be added. **If your account is in arrears for 120 days it will be handed over to the debt collectors.**

Parents must realise that they are getting a value for money product at Hopefield High. Paying your school fees punctually is the best investment you can make and definitely the right thing to do!

School fees can be paid at the financial secretary from 7 January (08 – 13:00). Contact our financial secretary, Mrs, Pretorius, for more information with regards to any matters relating to school, bus and hostel fees. School and bus fees can be paid at school by debit or credit card.

We also want to stress the fact that no learner will be allowed in hostels or on buses unless all school, hostel or bus fees are settled in full.

36. Resolusie 1 – 100% HSH

Tydens die Begrotingsvergadering is die volgende resolusie eenparig deur die ouers teenwoordig aanvaar: 'n minimum maandelikse betaling van R250 skoolgeld deur alle HSH-ouers word aanvaar. Gesien in die lig dat daar in die 2018 boekjaar R2 064 552 afgeskryf is a.g.v. kwytskeldings asook die kwaliteit onderrig wat alle leerders by HSH ontvang, word 'n beroep op ouers wat vrystelling ontvang, gedoen om hierdie minimum betaling van R250 per maand te doen. Hierdie resolusie is nie afdwingbaar nie, maar ons doen 'n beroep op ouers wat vrystelling ontvang om ook hulle 100% vir HSH te gee en sodoende 'n bydrae te lewer tot die skep van 'n uitnemende skool.

37. Fundraisings 2019

After consulting with our learners, it became very clear that having air conditioners in classrooms is at the very top of their wish lists. During a Governing Body meeting it was then decided that funds raised during the Kaskenades will be used to install air conditioners in classrooms. The School Communicator is a lightweight application and should have no noticeable impact on your computer. In some instances you might need to change your anti-virus or firewalls settings to allow the School Communicator to run. If you are on a company network you might need to ask your network administrator to assist you. Over 100 000 parents are already successfully using the School Communicator, both at home and at work.
