3. Air conditioners

4. **Handboeke**

5. **Parking in Victoria Street**

We urge parents to be very careful in Victoria Street, especially at the beginning and end of school days. We also urge parents not to double park in Victoria Street when dropping learners off or picking learners up. Double parking poses a huge risk for our learners, especially when crossing the street.

6. **New winter uniform**

For the past few years our girls have been in our ears about a more effective uniform for the cold winter mornings of Hopefield. Last year the Governing Body went through a very extensive process of research and consultation about a new winter uniform for our girls. The ethos and character of the school, the good appearance of our girls and the cost implications, among other factors, were taken into account. After a very thorough process, the Governing Body approved the new uniform during a meeting held on 4 November 2020. The result of our decision was evident in the spontaneous applause from our girls when this decision was communicated to them. This winter dress will be kept in stock at the school. Price range from R300 to R365. Orders were taken for the new dresses. This will be optional as school uniform from May 2021, but will be compulsory from May 2022. 8. **School Governing Body Election**

Parents were notified in writing, via social media platforms and through flyers about the upcoming Governing Body elections on 23 and/or 30 March. Seven parent representatives must be elected and parents are invited to be part of this very important process.

Beheerliggaamverkiesings vind elke 3 jaar plaas en ouers kan ander ouers nomineer op die nominasievorm wat aan die kennisgewing van die verkiesing geheg is.

'n Kworum van 10% van ouers op die kieslys word benodig sodat die nominasie- en verkiesingsvergadering kan voortgaan. Indien daar nie 'n kworum by die eerste vergadering op 23 Maart is nie, moet dit vir 'n ander dag herbelê word en dieselfde proses soos hierbo genoem, moet herhaal word. 'n Kennisgewing vir die tweede verkiesingsvergadering (30 Maart) moet duidelik meld dat daar hierdie keer geen kworum nodig sal wees nie.

Vanjaar se Beheerliggaamverkiesing gaan verskil van vorige verkiesings in die sin dat dit 'n deurstapverkiesing gaan wees. **Dit impliseer dat stembusse op die verkiesingsdag om 08:00 gaan oopmaak en om 18:00 sluit.** In die vorige nuusbrieff is verkeerdelik gekommunikeer dat die stembusse 20:00 sluit. Die stemproses vind in die skoolsaal plaas. Parents are also request to bring an ID or driver's licence as proof of identity.

Elaine Meintjes



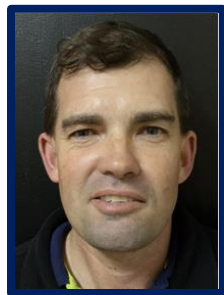
