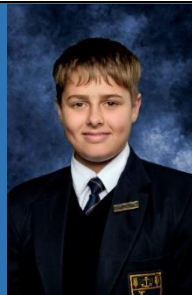

6. SLAAGVEREISTES

10. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2026

10.1 Subsidies and exemption of school fees

All school and bus fees must be paid in advance and we depend on your support. Only your punctual payments will relieve the pressure on the cash flow of the school. Parents who qualify for exemption on school and hostel fees must please fetch the forms from Mrs Kaufmann, our financial secretary. Completed forms must be handed in no later than 06 February 2026. Forms must be handed in with all required documentation. Exemption forms will be available at the financial office from 12 January 2026. Parents must also note that school fees will be charged once off, but are payable over 11 months.

Very important: First payment for school, bus and hostel fees payable before or on 07 January 2026.

If your account is in arrears for 120 days, it will be handed over to the debt collectors.

Parents must realise that they are getting a value for money product at Hopefield High. Paying your school fees punctually is the best investment you can make and definitely the right thing to do!

School fees can be paid at the financial secretary from 12 January (08:00 – 13:00). Contact our financial office for more information concerning any matters relating to school, bus and hostel fees. School and bus fees can be paid at school by debit or credit card.

We also want to stress the fact that no learner will be allowed in hostels or on buses unless all school, hostel or bus fees in arrears for 2025, are settled in full.

10.2 Hair

Very important!

Parents must ensure that boys' and girls' hair are cut according to school rules. Dye does not wash out after 20 washes: pupils should refrain from dying their hair. Parents and pupils should note that instructions on hair dye may not always be accurate. Strict disciplinary steps will be taken against pupils with dyed hair at the beginning of the school year. We urge parents to assist us in this regard.

10.3 Skooltasse

Ons versoek ouers om toe te sien dat leerders aan die begin van die nuwe skooljaar geen graffiti op skooltasse sal hê nie en dat ouers ook sal toesien dat slegs swart of donkerblou tasse met interne versterking aangekoop word om te verseker dat leerders se boeke in 'n goeie toestand sal bly. HSH-skooltasse word ook by die klerebank verkoop.

10.4 Swimming Caps

Due to problems with hair in our filters, pupils must have swimming caps when they use the school's pool. Caps may be bought at school from Mrs Cathrin Maree.

10.5 LO-Klere

10.6 Vakkeuse

Ouers word ingelig dat geen vakveranderinge meer in Gr. 12 mag plaasvind nie. Vakveranderinge vir Gr. 12 moet voor 10 Desember 2025 plaasvind. (Maksimum 1 vak.) Die laaste dag vir Gr. 11 vakveranderinge in 2026 (maksimum 2 vakke) is 27 Maart. Die laaste dag vir Gr. 10 vakveranderinge in 2025 (maksimum van 2 vakke) is 26 Junie. In alle gevalle moet ouers skriftelik toestemming gee. (Sien vakveranderingsvorm op webwerf.)

12. TEXT BOOKS AND EXERCISE BOOKS

Learners will receive lists indicating the exercise books needed for 2026. It may be bought in advance at any store, or from school on the very first school day. All text and exercise books must be **covered with plastic on 28 January**. See instructions in the Prospectus. Class teachers will do a book inspection on this date.

14. DISSCIPLINE

Effektiewe dissipline is een van die hoekstene van HSH se suksesverhaal en dit gaan verseker so bly.

Ons vestig ouers se aandag daarop dat HSH 'n puntestelsel het waarvolgens leerders punte verloor vir negatiewe gedrag / oortredings, of positiewe punte kry vir positiewe gedrag. U is welkom om ons dissiplinêre beampte, mev. Cathrin Maree, gedurende skoolure te kontak i.v.m. navrae oor u kind se punte t.o.v. gedrag.

We want to stress the fact that all learners must wear school uniform or the official school sports dress when attending school sport matches. Please see to it that learners adhere to this rule.

According to our Code of Conduct, one form of corrective discipline is detention. Detention will take place on Fridays and not on any other day of the week. Parents are responsible for learners' transport after detention. We also remind parents that HSH is a cell phone free area and that learners are not allowed to bring cell phones to school or any school activities. Cell phones will be confiscated and kept in safekeeping for a maximum of three calendar months if this rule is transgressed. See our revised Code of Conduct on the school's website and our social media platforms.

15. PROTOCOL

HSH strives for excellence, but we are certainly not perfect. What are parents to do when they experience problems? If the problem is curriculum-related, contact the subject teacher or consult with the teacher on Parent Evenings. If the outcome of this conversation is not satisfactory, contact the principal. If you have any other queries, contact the teacher in charge and if you are not happy, contact the principal.

16. REPORT CARDS

In the past we received numerous requests to e-mail or fax report cards. We agreed to do it, but were informed that WCED policy states that report cards are legal documents and parents must receive the original report card. Therefore, no report cards will be faxed or e-mailed. Report cards will be handed over personally to each learner on the last day of each school term. We also need to stress that school attendance on the last school day is absolutely compulsory.

17. HOMEWORK BOOKS

We want to stress the fact that every learner must have a homework book.

18. SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

We want to stress the fact that school attendance during the last week of each school term is compulsory and that formal assessment tasks will be completed in all grades during the last week of the first three terms.

19. AFWESIGHEID

U word versoek om leerder-afwesigheid onmiddellik met die skool te kommunikeer. Ouers se aandag word daarop gevestig dat alle leerders wat die skool gedurende skooltyd verlaat of later aanmeld, 'n register by die sekretaresse moet teken.

20. SCHOOL SPORT BAGS

We remind parents that school sport bags can be ordered at the school. The bags are in two sizes (big and small) and are in the colours of the school with the school's badge printed on it. Contact Mrs Cathrin Maree at hshklerebank@gmail.com to place an order as soon as possible.

21. MARKING OF SCHOOL UNIFORM

Parents are requested to see to it that all school and sport uniforms are clearly marked. The secretary's office is overflowing with lost school uniforms, especially after sport events, and these costly uniforms are rarely claimed. We have more than 750 learners with exactly the same uniform and if the items are not clearly marked, there will be confusion. Thank you for your co-operation.

22. LEARNERS OUT OF SCHOOL GROUNDS

We are living in dangerous times, even in the tranquillity of Hopefield. We need to manage these risks at school and therefore we need to inform parents that no learner will be allowed to leave the school grounds during school hours. The only exception will be when a parent or legal guardian accompanies a learner in person from the school grounds, with a valid reason and with permission from the principal.

23. ILLNESS DURING EXAMINATIONS / ASSESSMENT

It happens from time to time that learners fall ill during exams or when Formal Assessment Tasks are completed. **When learners are absent, the school must be informed and a doctor's or clinic certificate must be handed in at school.** When a learner is absent with a valid medical certificate, the learner will get an 'absent' and his/her term mark will reflect all the other tasks completed for that specific subject. **In such cases no learner will receive a class average mark or a zero mark.**

We also get requests to accommodate learners not feeling well during exam/assessment by letting them take their tests outside the normal exam times. We simply cannot manage these requests for the simple reason of question paper security and time constraints. We certainly appreciate the fact that a learner who is not feeling well, still wants to complete his/her exam papers, but these exam papers must be completed at the same time as the other learners completing these subjects.

24. RESOLUSIE 1 – 100% HSH

According to the South African Schools Act 84 of 1996 school fees are payable yearly in advance. A downpayment over a maximum 11 month period is regarded as a privilege. All fees are strictly payable in advance on/before the 7th of each month. Resolution 1 is 15% of annual school fees, payable monthly per child by parents who qualified for exemption of school fees. Bus fees are calculated annually per school day. The total cost is then divided into monthly installments. Bus fees must be paid every month, including school holiday months as well. If your payment is made when the school re-opens in January, the next payment will be due on/before 07 February. PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT HOSTEL AND SCHOOL FEES ARE PAID INTO SEPARATE BANK ACCOUNTS BANK ACCOUNTS ARE AS FOLLOW: PLEASE USE ACCOUNT NUMBER OR CHILDS NAME & SURNAME AS REFERENCE.

According to the South African Schools Act 84 of 1996 school fees are payable yearly in advance. A downpayment over a maximum 11 month period is regarded as a privilege. All fees are strictly payable in advance on/before the 7th of each month. Resolution 1 is 15% of annual school fees, payable monthly per child by parents who qualified for exemption of school fees. Bus fees are calculated annually per school day. The total cost is then divided into monthly installments. Bus fees must be paid every month, including school holiday months as well. If your payment is made when the school re-opens in January, the next payment will be due on/before 07 February. 27. SCHOOL ADMISSIONS 2026

The admission process for 2026 is completed and 1000 applications were processed up to this date. Only 122 of the applications could be placed. School Management and the Governing Body will continue to manage school admissions in the best interest of the Hopefield High School community.

28. HSH PASS

We also remind our parents about the HSH Pass. Learners who meet the requirements of this pass will get a green stamp on their report cards. This is an effort to create an environment of academic excellence at Hopefield High School – an additional pass criteria implemented in Grades 4-12. These pass requirements do not replace the minimum promotion requirements. It is an effort to motivate learners not just to aim for a pass, but to get them to work for better marks.

The minimum requirements for a HSH Pass are as follow:

Grade 4 – 7: An average of 65% in all subjects and no subject below 50%.

Grade 8 – 12: An average of 55% in all subjects and no subject below 40%.

29. REVISED WEIGHTINGS

The program of assessment for each grade consists of a composition of tasks, tests, examinations, practical assessment tasks (practical subjects) and oral tasks (Languages), specific to each subject and grade. In addition to the review of the Annual Teaching Plans, the 2020 School Based Assessment and Examination weightings are amended as follows:

PHASE	2023 REVISED SBA WEIGHTINGS
Foundation (Grade R-3)	100% SBA
Intermediate (Grade 4-6)	80% (SBA) : 20% (Exams)
Senior Phase (Grade 7-9)	60% (SBA) : 40% (Exams)
Grade 10 & 11	40% (SBA) : 60% (Exams)
Grade 12	25% (SBA) : 75% (Exams)

From the table above, the ratio of SBA and examinations in all grades remain the same except in the Senior Phase
