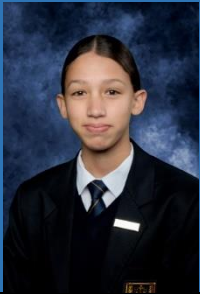

We also remind our parents about the HSH Pass. Learners who meet the requirements of this pass, will get a green stamp on their report cards. This is an effort to create an environment of academic excellence at Hopefield High School – an additional pass criteria implemented in Grades 4-12. These pass requirements do not replace the minimum promotion requirements. It is an effort to motivate learners not just to aim for a pass, but to get them to work for better marks.

The minimum requirements for HSH Pass are as follow:

- ➔ Grade 4-7: An average of 65% in all subjects and no subject below 50%
- ➔ Grade 8-12: An average of 55% in all subjects and no subject below 40%.

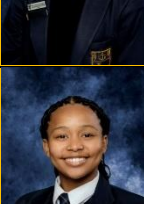

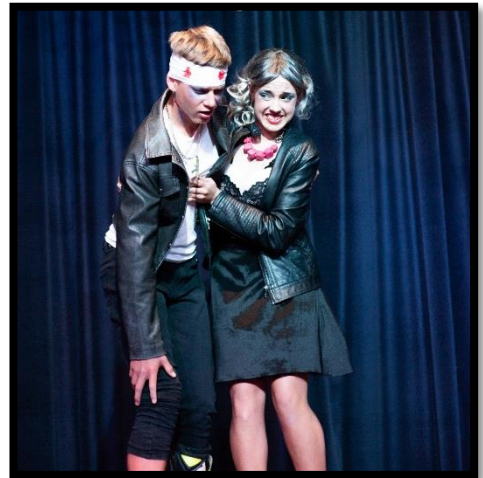

Parents are also reminded that the wear of grey shorts for Gr. 4-11 boys is compulsory during Term 1 and 4.

16. SCHOOL ADMISSIONS 2026

The admission process for 2026 is completed and 987 applications were processed up to this date. Only 133 of the applications could be placed. School Management and the Governing Body will continue to manage school admissions in the best interest of the Hopefield High School community.

17. MARKING OF SCHOOL UNIFORM

We have heaps of school uniform and other items in the "lost and found" crates. Parents are urged to see that all clothes of learners are clearly marked.

18. ADVERTENSIEBORDE

19. TWEEDE DETENSIEBRIEF

NB! Wanneer 'n leerder 'n tweede (of volgende) detensiebrief ontvang, verander die sanksies na 4 detensies. Die Beheerliggaam behou die reg voor om kroniese oortreders dissiplinêr te verhoor. Met die ontvangs van 'n tweede (of volgende) detensiebrief, verloor die leerder die voorreg om aan die eerste skoolaktiwiteit wat dan sal volg, deel te neem. Skoolaktiwiteite sluit in kultuur, sport, uitstappies, ens.

When a learner receives a second (or follow-up) letter for detention, the sanctions change to 4 detentions. The SGB is reserving the right to conduct disciplinary hearings with repeat offenders. When receiving a second (or follow-up) letter for detention, a learner forfeits the privilege to take part in the first school activity that follows. School activities include culture, sport, excursions, etc.

20. AFWESIGHEID

At this meeting, the proposed budget for the financial year 2026 will be presented to all parents for consideration and approval. The budget reflects the school's estimated income and expenditure for the year ahead and is essential for ensuring the effective functioning of our school. In addition, the audited financial statements for the previous year will be presented in accordance with sections 42 and 43 of the Schools Act.

In accordance with the Act, the following arrangements apply:

- A quorum of at least 10% of parents is required for the first meeting to proceed. Should this quorum not be met, a second meeting will be held on the 29th of October 2025 at 18:00, at which no quorum is required.

We therefore urge all parents to attend and participate actively in this important meeting, as the decisions taken directly affect the quality of education and resources available to our learners.
